

Barnesville Education Association/ Barnesville High School Scholarship Guidelines

The BEA scholarship provides graduating seniors of Barnesville High School, who have throughout the course of their high school career, demonstrated their support and understanding of the complexities of public education. The following criteria apply for eligibility for this scholarship award.

- Applicant must have a resume of community/school activities
- Applicant must be attending a 2-4 year college/university/technical facility or other post-secondary educational institution
- Applicant must have a 7th semester GPA of 2.5 or better
- Applicant must submit a computer generated 12 point font, Times New Roman, 250 word count for each prompt, written response to the following:

What role has public education played in your families' quest to full-fill the "American Dream?"

Expound upon the role unions have played in America and the role they will play in the future?

Completion of these criteria is due to the guidance counselor by the 1st Monday in April.

Recommendation for the award will be based on review of the bulleted criteria and essay.

Awarding of the scholarship will take place during the annual spring awards assembly at Barnesville High School.
