

Guidelines for the
Barnesville High School
Key Club Chapter Scholarship

Key Club is an international student-led organization whose goal is to teach leadership through serving others. It provides its members with opportunities to provide service, build character and develop leadership. The Key Club scholarship was established to assist a member who exemplifies the organization's mission in post-secondary pursuits. The following criteria apply for eligibility for this \$500.00 scholarship award:

- *Must be a club member for your Junior and Senior year*
- *Must attend monthly meetings*
- *Must be an active participant in Key Club/Kiwanis events*
- *Dues must be paid in full by the end of September*
- *Applicant must be attending a 2-4 year college/university/technical facility or other post-secondary educational institution*
- *Applicant must have a 7th semester GPA of 2.5 or better*

Additionally, the applicant will submit a 500-word essay to the Key Club Advisor by the 1st Monday in April on the following topic:

Describe a Key Club service project that you have participated in that has had the greatest impact on you.

Recommendation for the award will be based on review of the bulleted criteria and the essay.

Awarding of the scholarship will take place during the annual spring awards assembly at the High School.
